IDENTIFICATION OF VOTERS

General Election to 250 Wards of the Municipal Corporation of Delhi 2022
- Instructions regarding identification of Electors at polling stations on
04.12.2022.

All electors to whom Elector Photo Identity Card (EPIC) have been issued, shall have to produce these to cast their vote at the polling station for the General Election to 250 Wards of the Municipal Corporation of Delhi, to be held on 04.12.2022. However, the electors to whom such EPIC have not been issued or whose EPIC have been lost/misplaced will be allowed to cast vote on production of any one of the following documents:-

- i) Aadhar Card,
- ii) MNREGA Job Card,
- iii) Passbook with photograph issued by bank/ Post Office,
- iv) Health Insurance Smart Card issued under the scheme of Ministry of Labour,
- v) Driving License,
- vi) PAN Card,
- vii) Smart Card issued by RGI under NPR,
- viii) Indian Passport,
- ix) Pension document with photograph,
- x) Service Identity Cards with photograph issued to employees by Central/State Govt., Public Sector Undertakings/Public Limited Companies and
- xi) Official Identity Cards issued to MPs/MLAs/MLCs and
- xii) Unique Disability ID (UDID) card, M/o Social Justice and empowerment, Govt. of India



Any of the above mentioned documents that is available only to the head of the family may be used for identifying the other members of the family provided all members come together and are identified by the head of the family.

As per clause 2 (m) of Public Distribution System (Control) Order, 2001, Ration Card shall not be admitted as document of Identity.

All voters for General Election to the 250 Wards of the Municipal Corporation of Delhi are, therefore, advised to carry with them the Elector's Photo Identity Card, or any of the above mentioned documents while going to cast their vote on **04.12.2022**.
