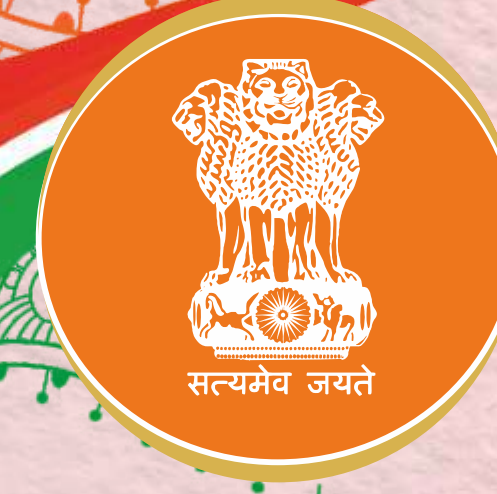

MESSAGE

State Election Commissioner

In the recent years, Panchayats and Municipalities have assumed greater significance as these local bodies are mandated to provide basic amenities that directly impact daily life of common masses. Elections to Local bodies, too, have gained greater prominence as local level democracy is the fundamental block of the entire democratic framework of India.

The State Election Commission in Delhi came into existence in October 1993 and over the years the Commission has overcome all challenges & obstacles to fulfill its constitutional mandate by successfully carrying out free and fair Municipal Elections in Delhi at regular intervals.

Consequent upon enactment of DMC (Amendment) Act, 2022 the erstwhile three Municipal Corporations of Delhi were unified to form a single Municipal Corporation of Delhi. Due to change in number of wards, fresh Delimitation of MCD wards was carried out in October, 2022, which paved way for conducting elections to the newly constituted unified Municipal Corporation of Delhi consisting of 250 wards.

Since the elections were already overdue, the Commission worked on war footing basis for preparing itself to conduct elections without any further delay. Schedule for Municipal Elections was announced with date of poll as 04.12.2022 and counting of votes on 07.12.2022.

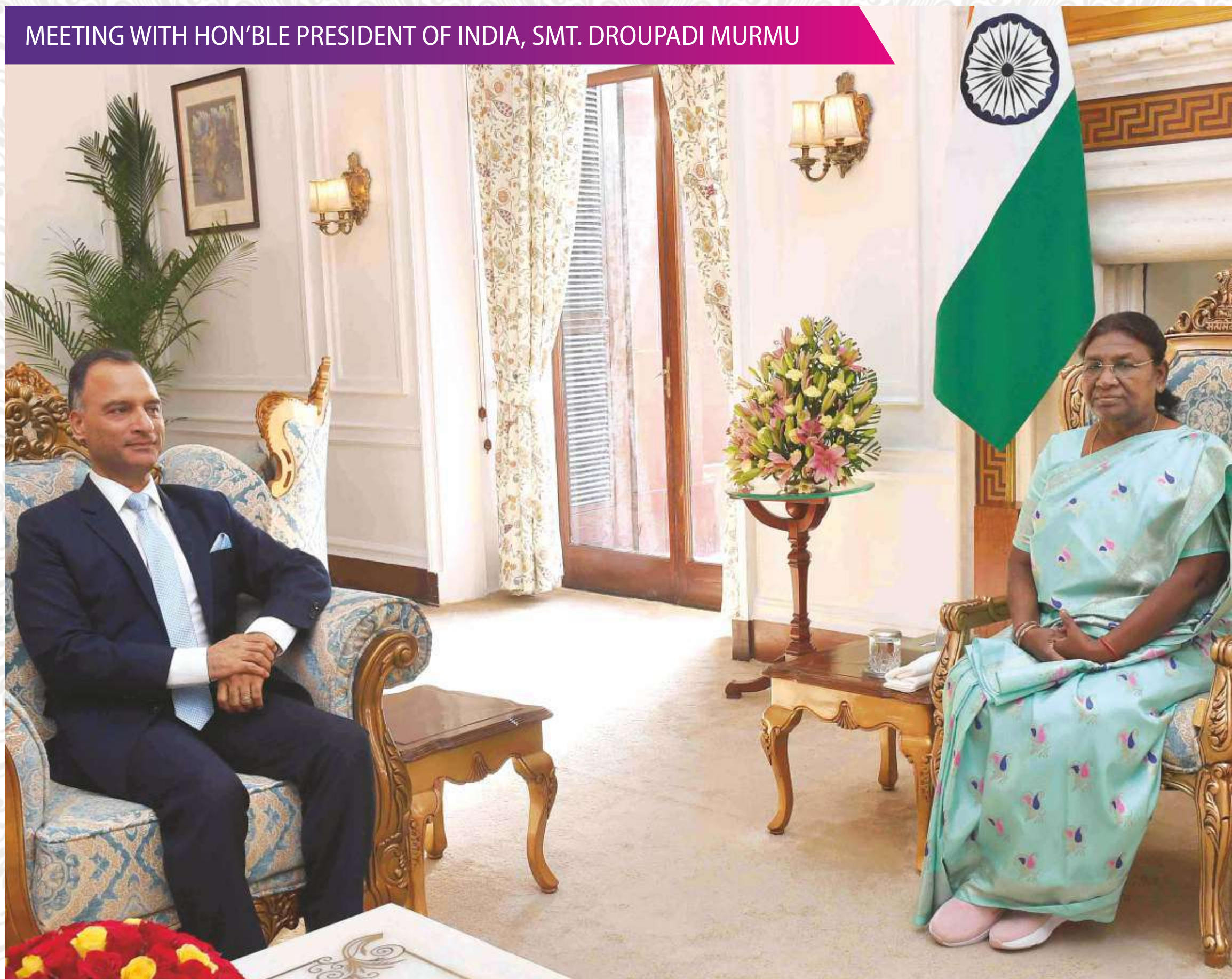
The MCD Elections-2022 were driven by use of extensive Information Technology. Special customized election software and unique mobile apps were used by the Commission and all-important election processes and actions were undertaken by the election functionaries on these e-platforms which enabled seamless flow of real-time information between various stakeholders thereby facilitating better co-ordination & control by the Commission. Besides the Information Technology initiatives, several other novel measures such as use of integrated electoral rolls, two-stage randomization of the polling parties and EVMs, launch of mobile app for generation of voter slips and to obtain voter information, facilitating ease of voting by Persons with Disability/Voters of age 80 years and above etc were undertaken by the Commission.

In order to empower, increase awareness and motivate the electorate for a robust participative democracy, the Commission launched an extensive Media Campaign through all available mediums of mass publicity of Print, Electronic and Social Media.

Through this Coffee Table Book, the State Election Commission, NCT of Delhi has strived to document the journey of General Elections to Municipal Corporation of Delhi- 2022. Coffee Table Book contains some glimpses of the MCD Elections-2022 process with a view to document and preserve the good work of our team.

Consequent upon enactment of DMC (Amendment) Act-2022, the erstwhile three Municipal Corporations of Delhi were unified to form a single Municipal Corporation of Delhi. The reduction in number of wards from 272 to 250 necessitated fresh Delimitation of MCD wards. The Delimitation process was completed in October-2022, which paved way for conducting elections to the unified Municipal Corporation of Delhi. The schedule for conducting elections to the newly constituted unified Municipal Corporation of Delhi was announced by Hon'ble State Election Commissioner in the press conference held on 04.11.2022.

The electoral management involved huge mobilization of more than 2,00,000 election officials and security personnel. The logistics management involved movement and deployment of Polling Parties/ EVMs/Election material and setting up of Polling stations, Strong Rooms/Counting Centres.

The Commission made all possible efforts for ensuring a safe, secure and pleasant voting experience.

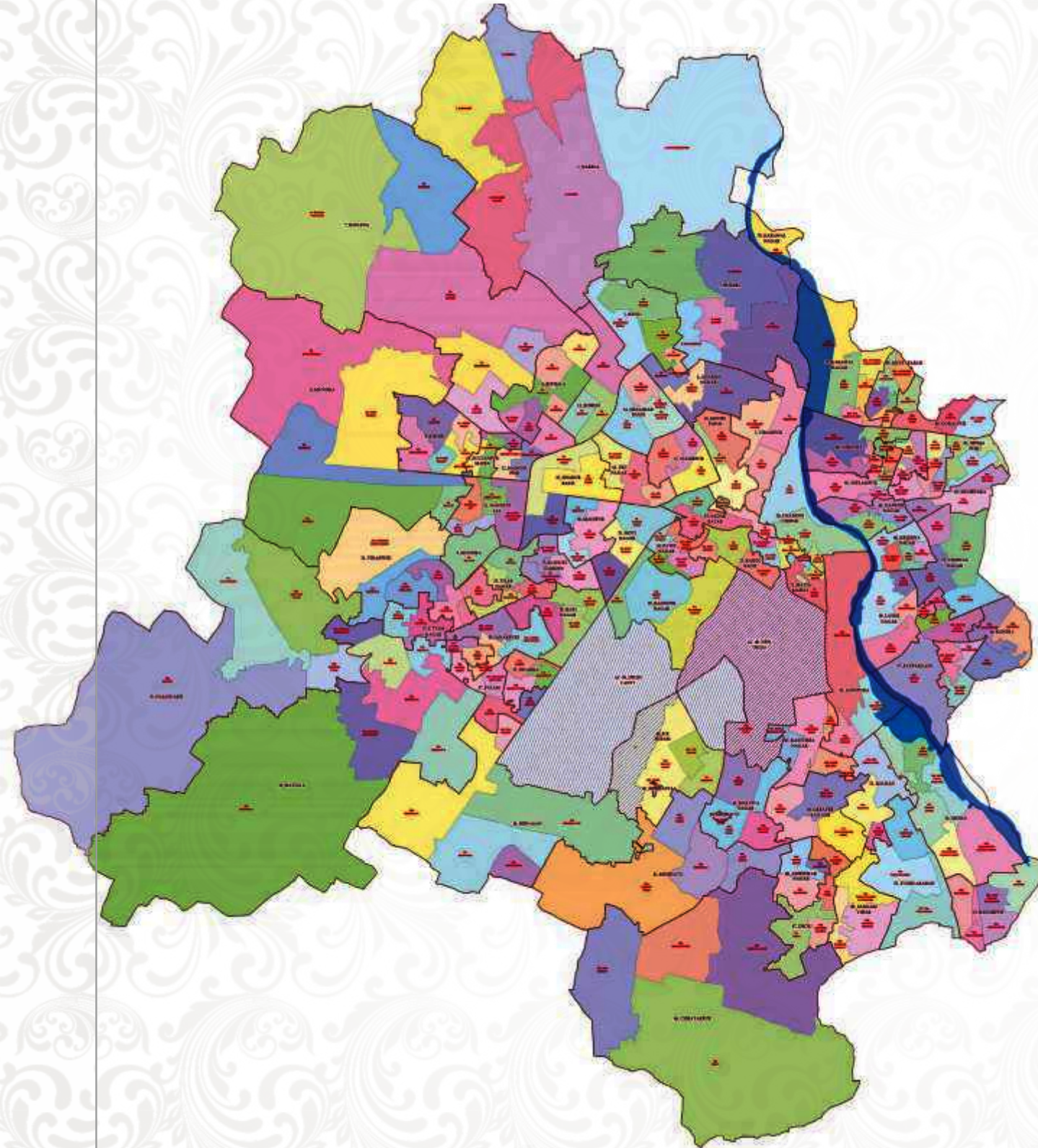

- MHA, Govt. of India constituted a three member Committee comprising of Dr. Vijay Dev, State Election Commissioner, NCT of Delhi & UT Chandigarh, Sh. Pankaj Kumar Singh, Additional Secretary, Ministry of Urban Development, Govt. of India and Sh. Randhir Sahay, Additional Commissioner, MCD to assist the Central Government in carrying out Delimitation of Municipal wards.
- The Central Government vide notification no. SG-DL-E-10092022-238734 dated 10th September, 2022 fixed total number of seats as 250 and having regard to SC population, 42 seats were reserved for members of Scheduled Castes including 21 seats for women of Scheduled Castes. Out of the remaining 208 seats, 104 seats were reserved for women.
- The latest available Census data of 2011 was used for delimitation.
- Indicative guidelines for delimitation were provided by MHA, Govt. of India.

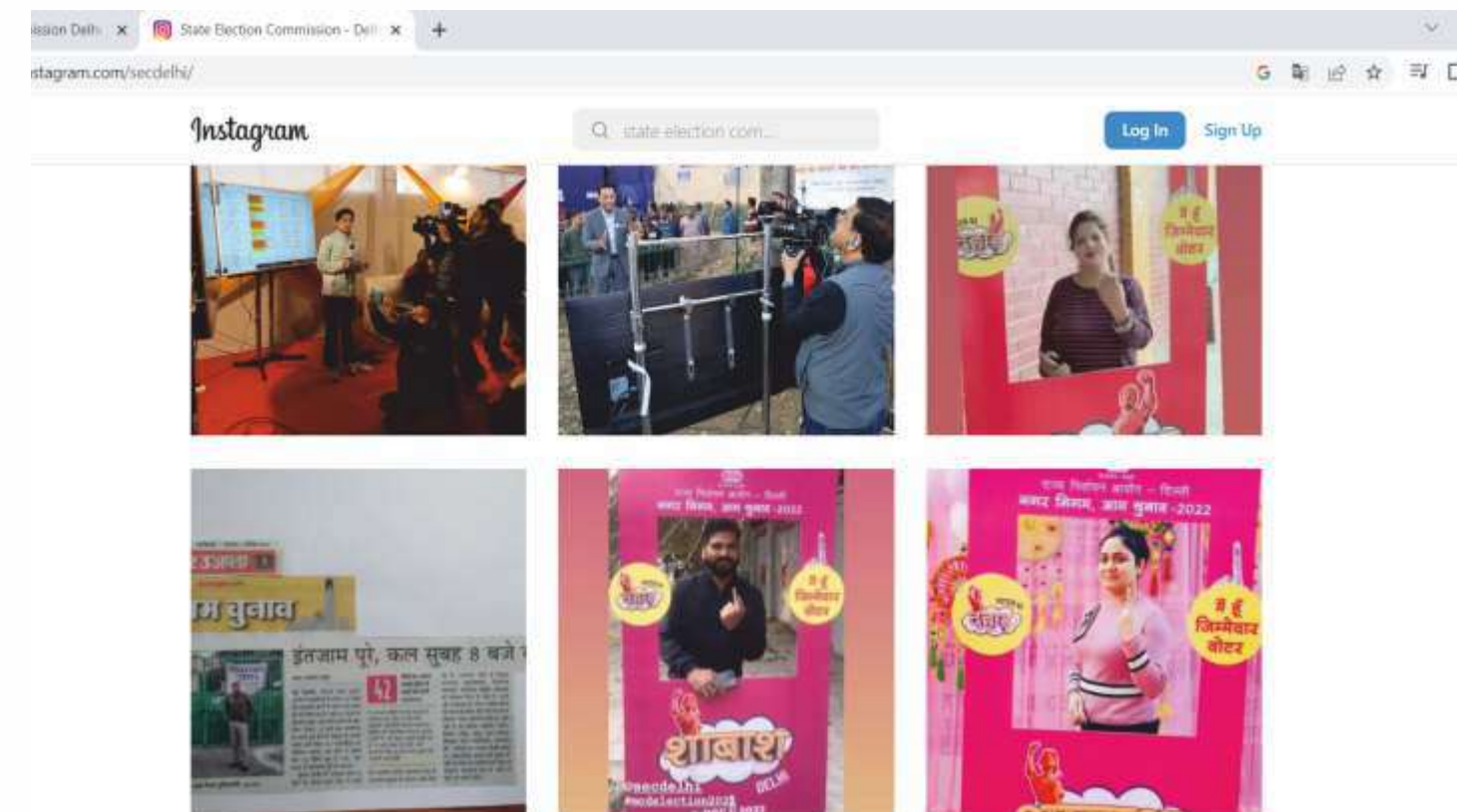
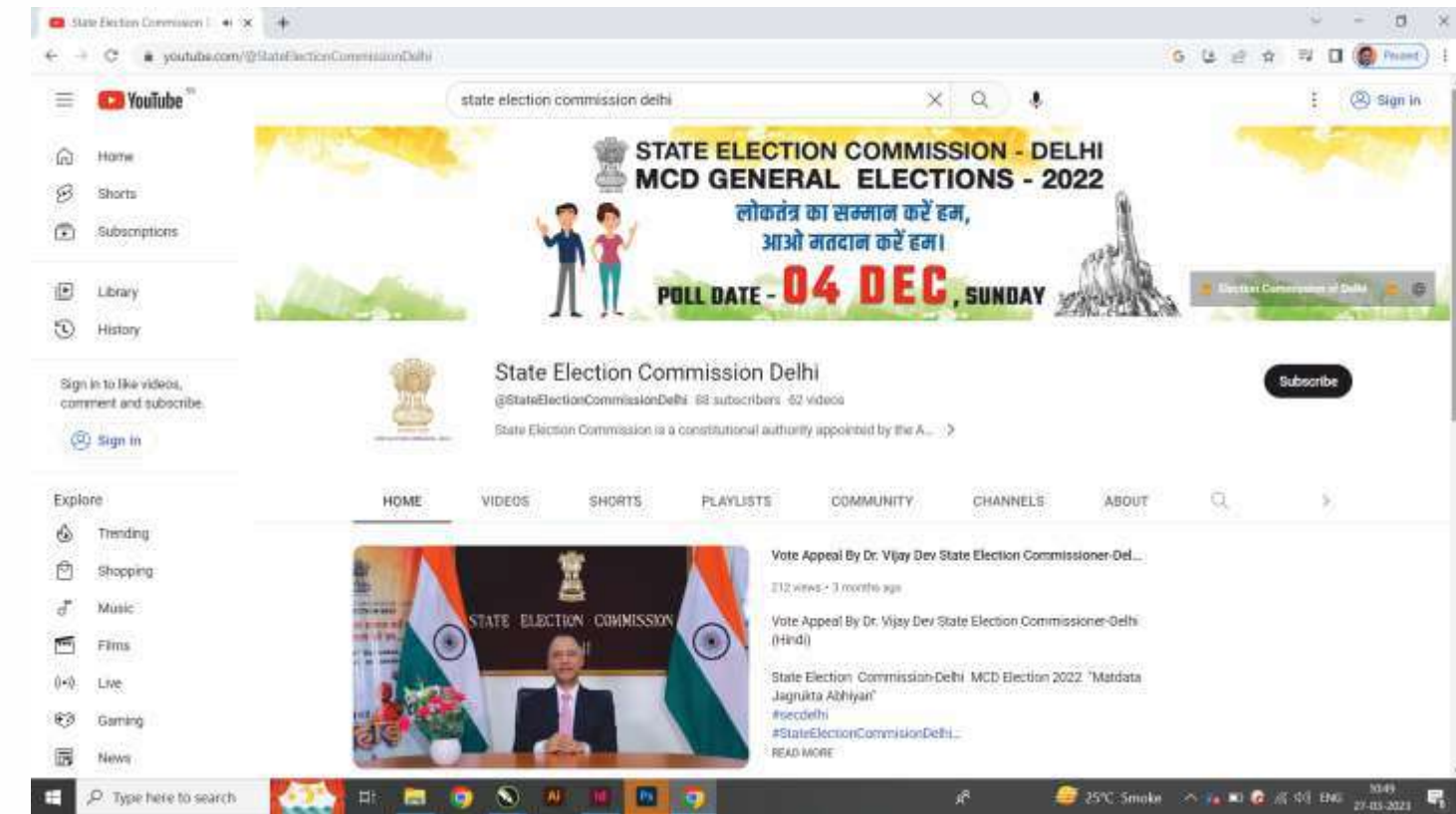
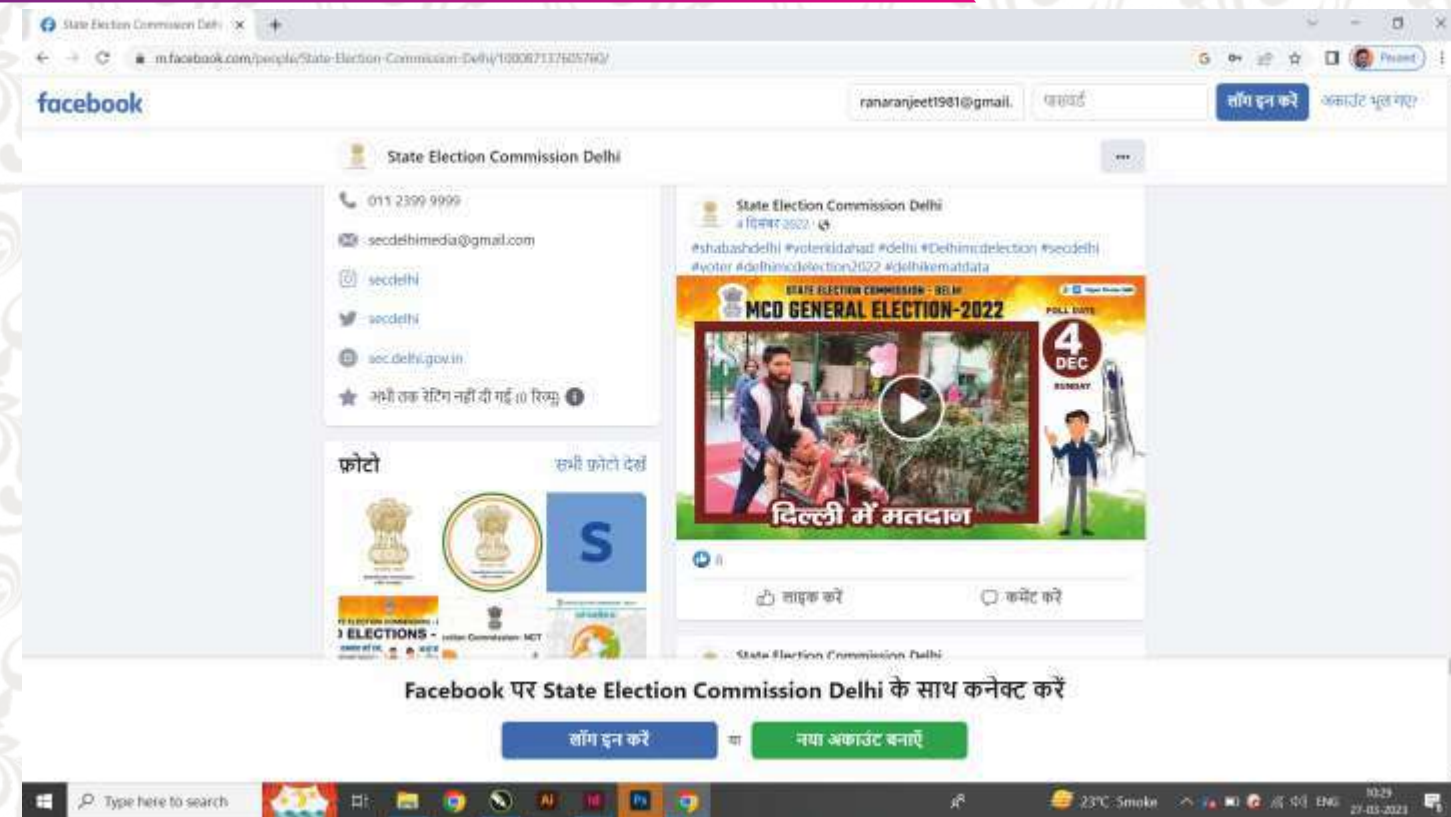

Delhi to go dry for 3 days due to MCD polls

New Delhi
Delhi will observe dry days from Friday to Sunday during which the sale of alcohol will be prohibited due to the MCD elections, the city excise department has announced.

The election of 250 wards of the Municipal Corporation of Delhi in the national capital is on Sunday. The counting of votes will be done on December 7.

The excise department has announced that December 7 will also be observed as a dry day.

In a notification, Delhi Commissioner (Excise) Krishna Mohan Uppu on Wednesday said that in pursuance of the provisions of Rule 52 of Delhi Excise Rules, 2010, it is hereby ordered that December 2 to December 4 and December 7 will be observed as "Dry Days".

Dry days are days when the government prohibits the sale of alcohol in shops, clubs, bars, etc. on a specific day "From 17:30 Hours of December 2, 2022 (Friday) to December 4, 2022, up to 17:30 Hours (Sunday), the above shall be observed as 'Dry Days' in addition to the Dry Days," the notification said.

Also, "from 00:00 Hours to 24:00 Hours on December 7, 2022 (Wednesday) (date of counting of votes), will also be observed as a dry day," the notification added.

The civic polls, spanning 250 wards, are due on December 4. The polls are largely being seen as a contest between the AAP, the BJP and the Congress.

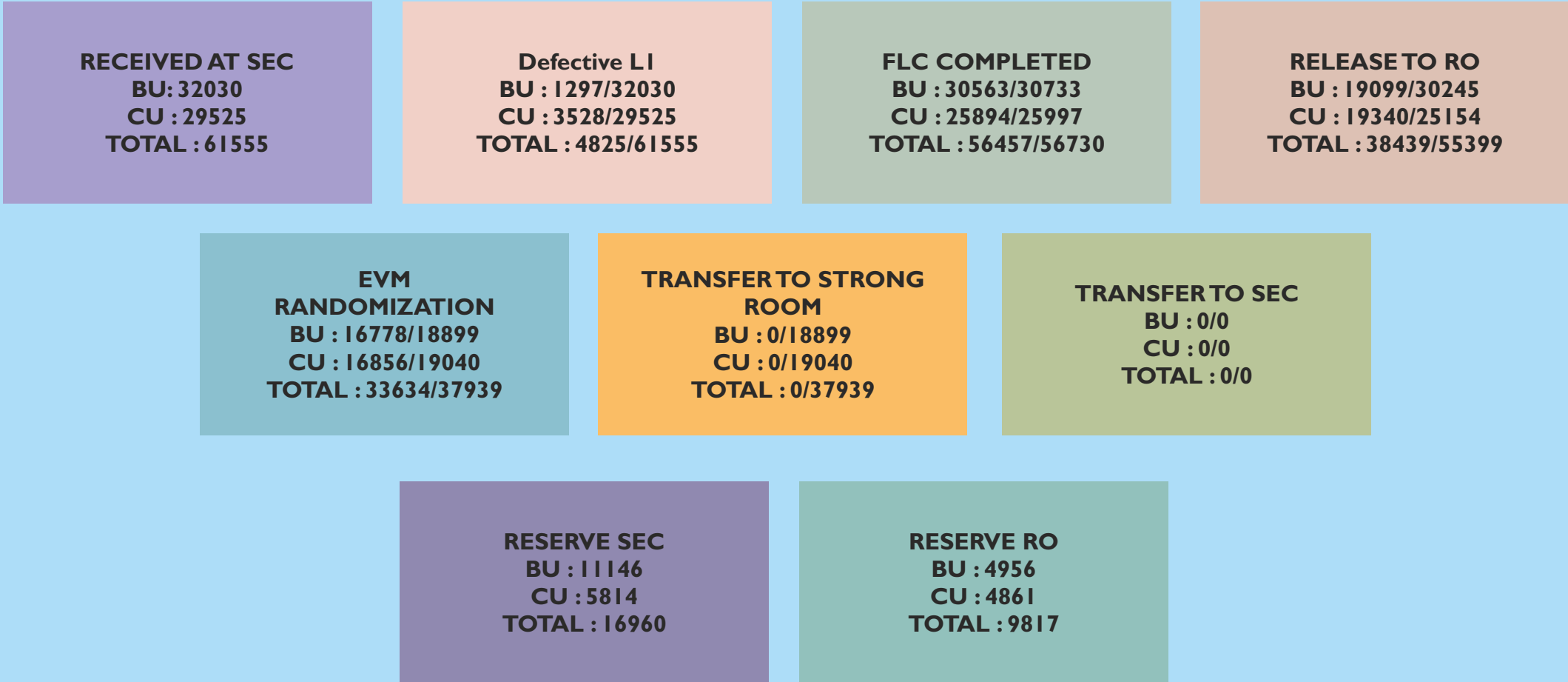

The first level randomization of parties was done at HQ level before distribution to Returning Officers (ROs). Second level randomization of parties was done by the ROs through customized software in the presence of Observers and deployment of parties was done accordingly.

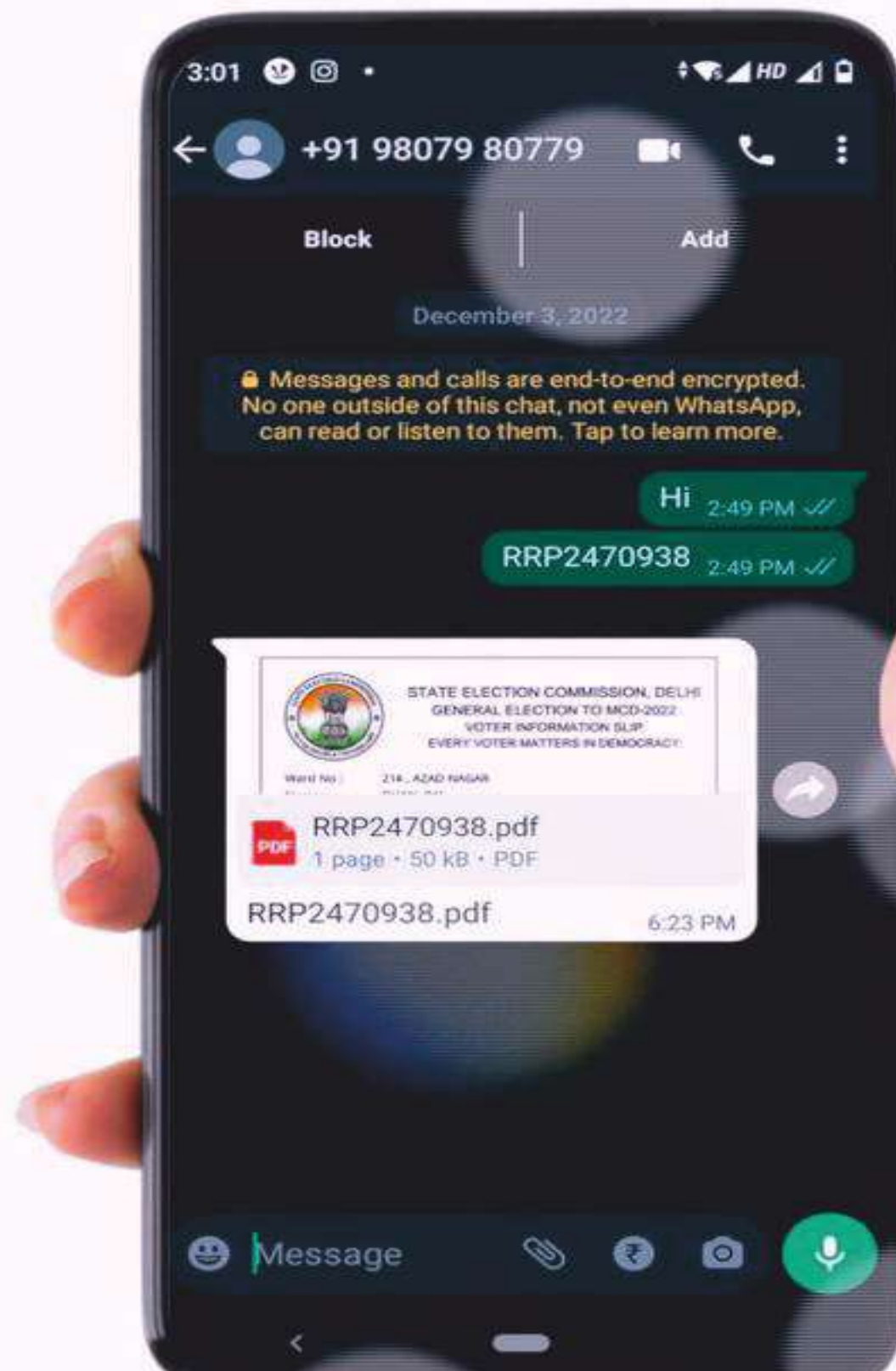

Live results of counting of votes were displayed on mobile app and web portal on Counting Day.Ward wise counting data was uploaded on the portal after every round and status of Lead/Winner candidate(s) was regularly updated to facilitate easy accessibility /viewing of the results by the officers, media and general public.

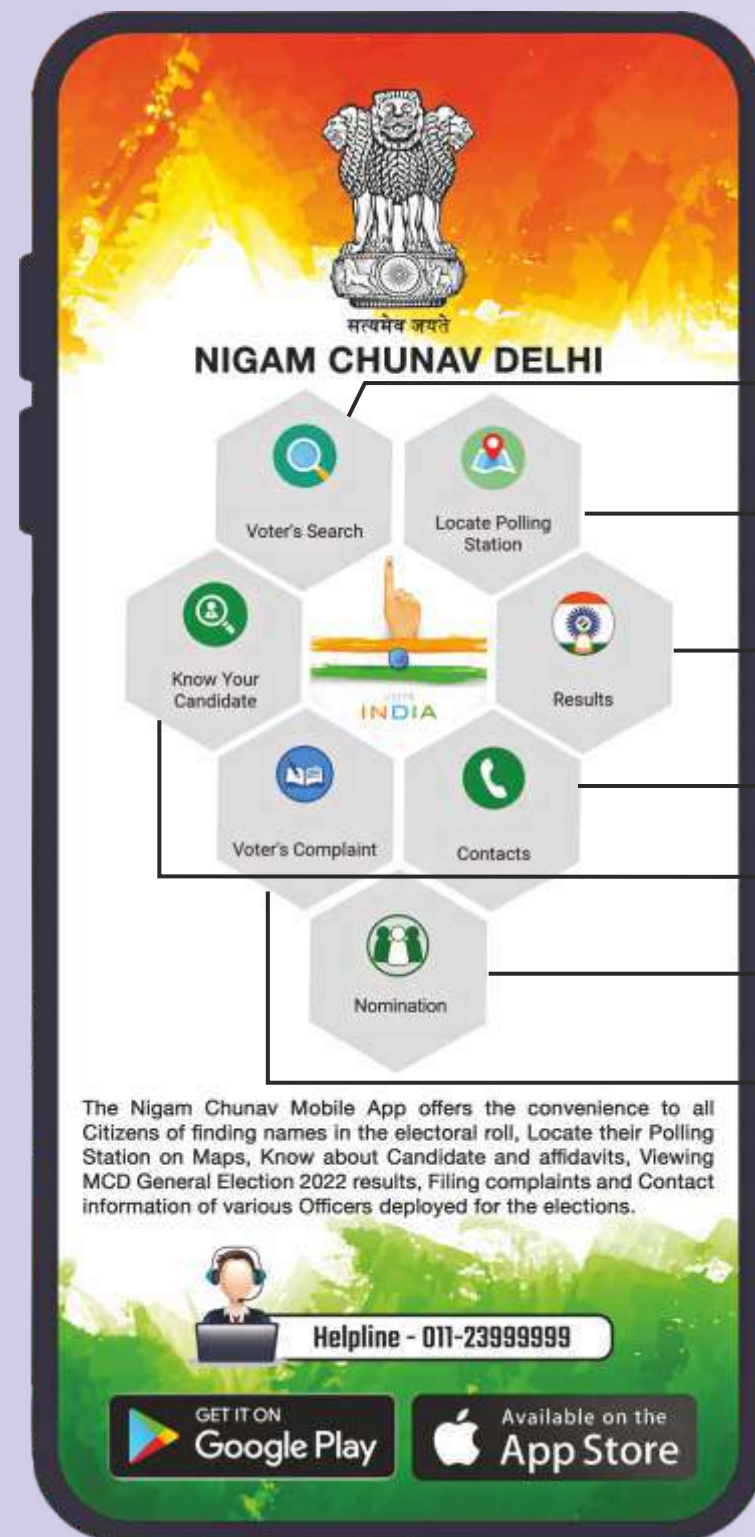

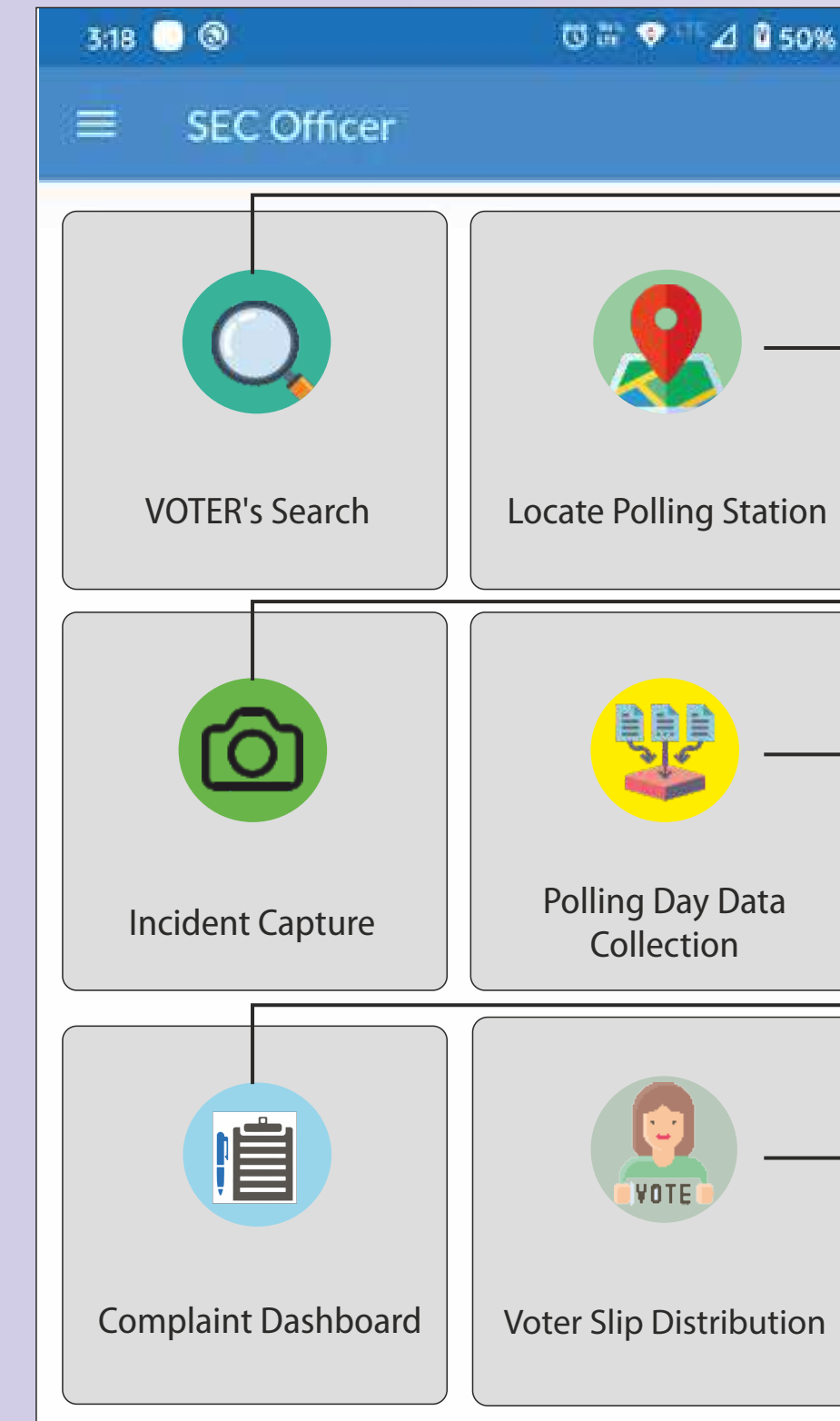

A total of 13638 polling stations were set up by the Commission which include one Model Polling station and one Pink Polling station in each of 68 assembly constituencies.

68 Model Polling stations were set up having facilities such as special waiting areas, helpers to facilitate voting by senior citizens, mobile deposit facility etc. were provided at these Model Polling stations. 68 Pink Polling Stations manned exclusively by women officers/officials were having facilities such as feeding room for lactating mothers/ crèche facility for small kids/ candies for kids.

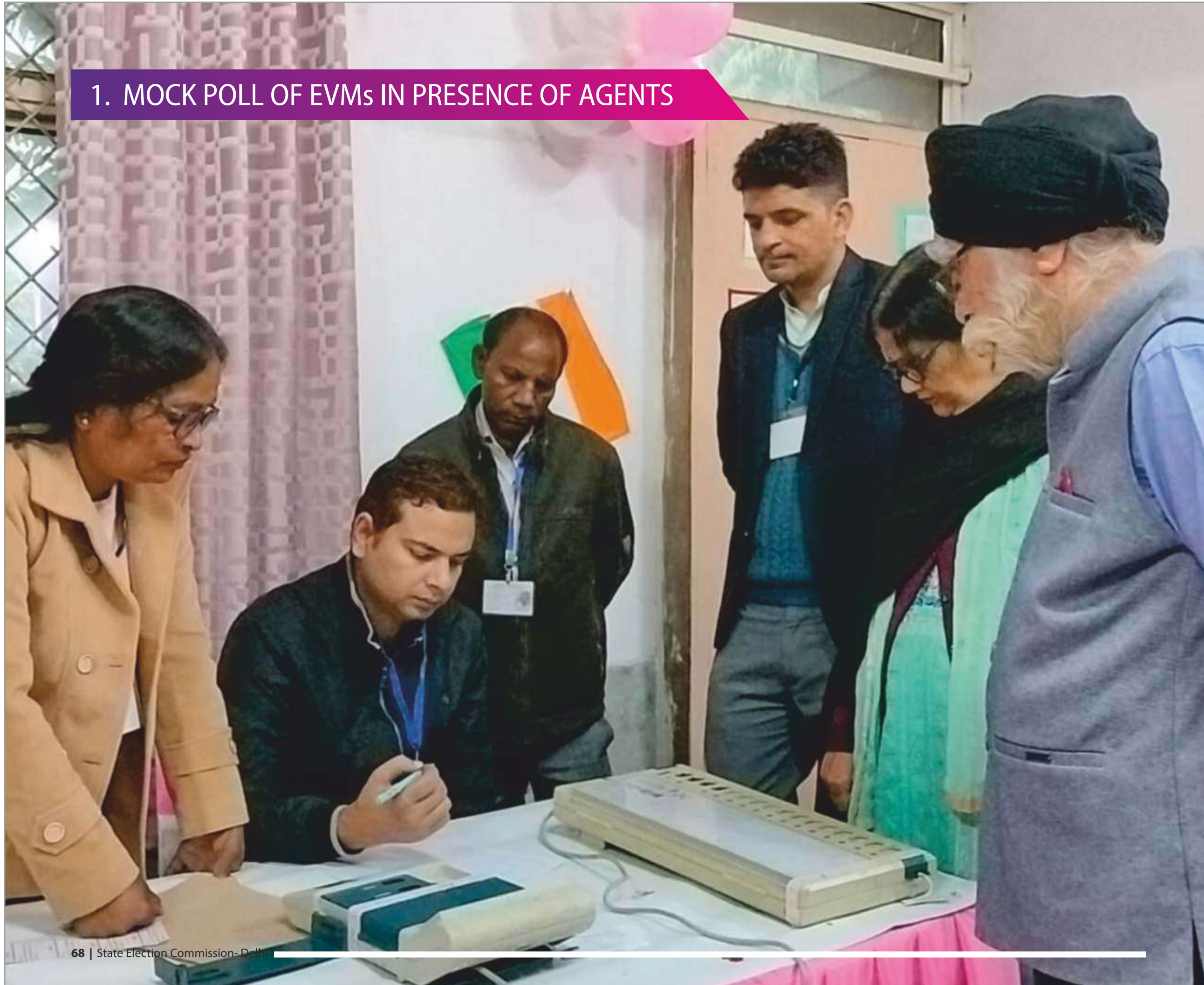
More than 15000 polling parties were prepared by the Commission for deployment at polling stations and 66 General Observers, 6 Special Observers and 1800 Sector Officers were also deployed for supervising the election process.

Around 170 Coys of Central Police Forces (CPFs), 55,000 personnel from Delhi Police and around 20,000 Home Guards from Delhi, Uttar Pradesh, Rajasthan and Haryana were deployed at the polling stations. On the polling day, arrangement for Web-Casting, Drone Surveillance and Micro-Observers was done at 3360 Sensitive/ Hyper sensitive polling stations.

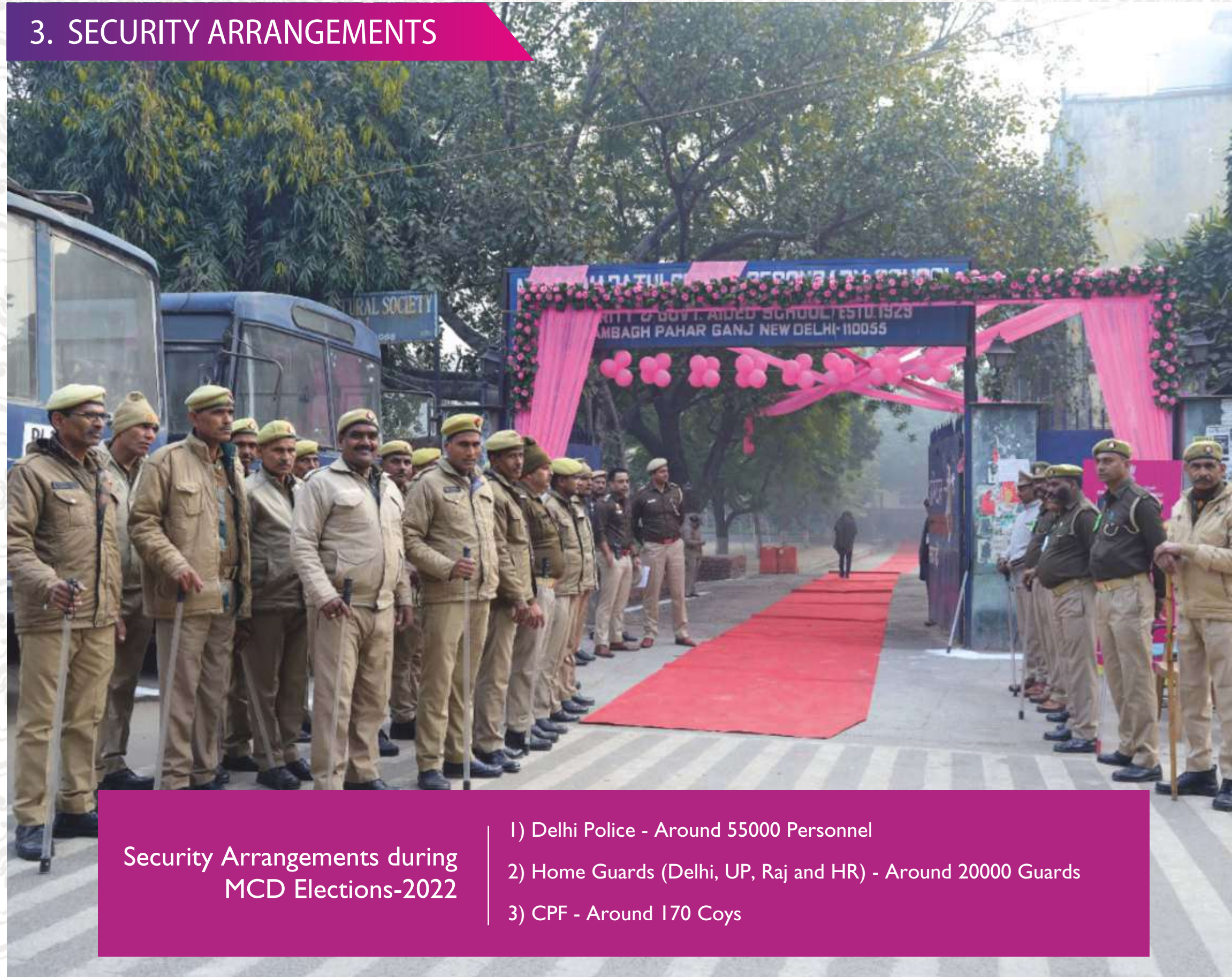

A total of 42 Counting Centres/Strong Rooms were set up by the Commission. Real-time data on counting of votes was received from all Counting Centres in a seamless manner by sharing of counting information through the Officer Mobile App and the Commission's web portal.

Media Centres were set up at each Counting Centre to facilitate media personnel covering the counting process. A dedicated Media Centre cum facilitation centre was also set up at the Commission's Head Quarter, wherein the 'counting of votes' dashboard on Commission's portal was displayed on large TV screens.

After completion of counting process, certificate of election to the winning candidates were presented by the concerned Returning Officers.

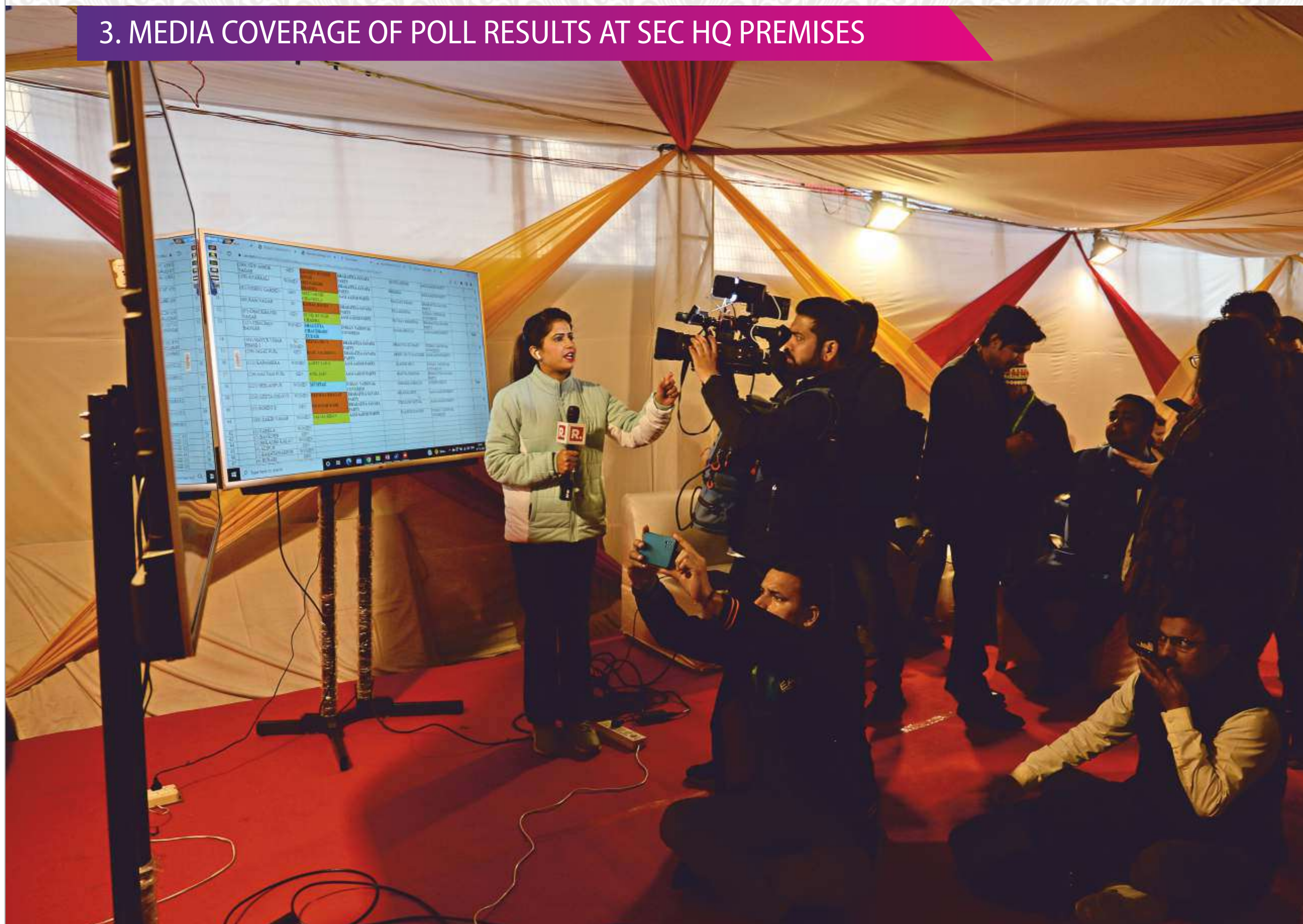
