Principles to be followed as guidance for the purposes of delimitation of wards as per census 2011 in respect of three Corporations of Delhi

- 1. Average population of each ward to be 60,000 with a variation of 10% to 15% approximately in the ward.
- 2. Boundary of ward should be within the boundary of the MLA constituency and shall not cross it.
- 3. Boundary of the ward should be clearly defined along roads/drains/railway lines so that there is no confusion on the boundary of the ward.
- 4. A Colony or slum cluster would be kept within a ward so that there is no division thereof between wards.
- 5. Use of Geospatial maps and data from the Census of India would be the primary data for the purposes of delimitation.
