Principles to be followed as guidance for the purposes of delimitation of wards as per census 2011 in respect of three Corporations of Delhi

1. Average population of each ward to be 60,000 with a variation of 10% to 15% approximately in the ward.
2. Boundary of ward should be within the boundary of the MLA constituency and shall not cross it.
3. Boundary of the ward should be clearly defined along roads/drains/railway lines so that there is no confusion on the boundary of the ward.
4. A Colony or slum cluster would be kept within a ward so that there is no division thereof between wards.
5. Use of Geospatial maps and data from the Census of India would be the primary data for the purposes of delimitation.
